MODERN HERITAGE SERIAL SITES: Nominations analysis

Background: There are at least 4 architectural oeuvres on World Heritage tentative lists already :Le Corbusier Frank Lloyd Wright, Henry Van der Velde, and potentially Alvar Aalto. Great men, great movements, but which properties demonstrate OUV ? Selection, context and management are all critical areas for analysis- as well as the tests of authenticity and integrity.

The GA presents an opportunity for informal discussion about the experience to date with serial nominations and identify what is needed in terms of comparative and thematic analysis for twentieth century heritage properties. The perspectives of nominators, advisers and assessors as well as ICOMOS will be open for consideration.
